



VICE ADMIRAL LYAL A. DAVIDSON, U.S. NAVY

LYAL AMENT DAVIDSON WAS BORN IN MUSCATINE, IOWA ON DECEMBER 2, 1886, SON OF COL. JOSEPH T. DAVIDSON AND MRS. (JUDITH AMENT) DAVIDSON. HE ATTENDED MUSCATINE HIGH SCHOOL AND WAS APPOINTED MIDSHIPMAN FROM IOWA IN 1906, ENTERING THE U.S. NAVAL ACADEMY ON JUNE 20, THAT YEAR, HE WAS GRADUATED WITH CREDIT IN JUNE 1910. HE SERVED THE TWO YEARS AT SEA, THEN REQUIRED BY LAW BEFORE COMMISSIONING, AND WAS COMMISSIONED ENSIGN IN MARCH 1912. BY SUBSEQUENT PROMOTIONS. HE ATTAINED THE RANK OF REAR ADMIRAL, TO DATE FROM NOVEMBER 30, 1941, AND RETIRED ON JUNE 1, 1946, WAS ADVANCED TO THE RANK OF VICE ADMIRAL ON THE BASIS OF COMMENDATION FOR CONDUCT WHILE A MEMBER OF A LANDING FORCE AT VERA CRUZ IN APRIL 1914, AND SUBSEQUENT DECORATIONS FOR COMBAT DURING WORLD WAR II.

VICE ADMIRAL DAVIDSON PARTICIPATED IN MANY OF THE SEA SUPPORT BATTLES OF WORLD WAR II AS COMMANDER CRUISER DIVISION 8 ABOARD HIS FLAGSHIP USS PHILADELPHIA. IN MOROCCO, ADMIRAL DAVIDSON AND HIS GUNFIRE TASK GROUP AIDED IN LANDING TROOPS AND EQUIPMENT WITHOUT SERIOUS DAMAGE OR LOSS OF LIFE. HIS AMAZING GUNFIRE SUPPORT DAZED THE GERMANS WHO BELIEVED THAT THE UNITED STATES WAS USING A NEW FORMIDABLE ANTI-TANK WEAPON. ADMIRAL DAVIDSON RECEIVED THE LEGION OF MERIT FOR HIS DARING LEADERSHIP AND BRILLIANT DIRECTION OF GUNFIRE SUPPORT. LATER AS COMMANDER OF TASK FORCE 86, HIS SUPPORT FORCE BECAME IN EFFECT "GENERAL PATTON'S NAVY" BY VIRTUE OF RAPID PLANNING AND EXECUTION OF OUTFLANKING OPERATIONS ALONG THE SICILIAN COAST. HE DENIED THE COAST ALMOST COMPLETELY TO THE ENEMY AND BECAME THE SEAGOING ARTILLERY FOR THE RAPID ADVANCE OF THE SEVENTH ARMY. GENERAL PATTON RESERVED HIS HIGHEST COMMENDATION FOR ADMIRAL DAVIDSON: "NOW THERE'S A FIGHTING SO-AND-SO."

VICE ADMIRAL DAVIDSON DIED AT THE U.S. NAVY HOSPITAL BETHESDA, MD, ON DECEMBER 29, 1950. HE IS SURVIVED BY HIS THREE CHILDREN, WILLIAM G. DAVIDSON, JUDITH A. DAVIDSON AND CAROLYN T. DAVIDSON.

USS DAVIDSON (FF-1045), THE FIRST SHIP IN THE UNITED STATES NAVY TO BEAR THE NAME, IS THE FIFTH IN THE GARCIA CLASS OF FRIGATES AND THE THIRD TO BE BUILT BY AVONDALE SHIPYARD INC. WESTWEGO, LOUISIANA. HER KEEL WAS LAID 30 SEPTEMBER 1963 AND SHE WAS CHRISTENED 2 OCTOBER 1964 BY HER SPONSOR, MRS. LYAL A. DAVIDSON, THE WIDOW OF THE SHIPS NAMESAKE. DAVIDSON ARRIVED IN HAWAII ON 13 APRIL 1966 TO JOIN DESTROYER FLOTILLA FIVE. SHE SAILED ON HER FIRST WESTERN PACIFIC TOUR (WESTPAC) ON 18 APRIL 1967 AND SAW HER FIRST VIETNAMESE GUNLINE ACTION 12 SEPTEMBER 1967. DAVIDSON SAW CONTINUOUS EMPLOYMENT AS NAVAL GUNFIRE SUPPORT SHIP DURING FOLLOWING DEPLOYMENTS UNTIL 17 OCTOBER 1969. SHE RECORDED HIGH MARKS FOR ACCURACY AND AMOUNTS OF AMMUNITION EXPENDED: A RECORD IN MAY 1972 FOR SHOOTING OVER 1200 ROUNDS IN ONE ALL-NIGHT BOMBARDMENT. SHE WAS NICKNAMED "THE BIGGEST LITTLE DESTROYER IN WESTPAC."

DAVIDSON EARNED BATTLE EFFICIENCY "E" AWARDS IN 1971, 1972 AND 1983. DAVIDSON'S GUN MOUNTS DISPLAY PERMANENT GOLD "E"S EARNED BY BEING THE MOST EFFICIENT GUNNERY DIVISION FOR FIVE YEARS STRAIGHT. DAVIDSON ALSO DISPLAYS THE FOLLOWING AWARDS: COMBAT ACTION RIBBON, MERITORIOUS UNIT COMMENDATION, NATIONAL DEFENSE SERVICE MEDAL, NAVY EXPEDITIONARY MEDAL, REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM CAMPAIGN MEDAL, REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM MERITORIOUS UNIT CITATION (CROSS OF GALLANTRY) AND THE VIETNAM SERVICE MEDAL.



COMMANDING OFFICER CDR. FRANK C. FERDON

CDR FRANK C. FERDON, USN, RECEIVED HIS COMMISSION FROM OFFICER CANDIDATE SCHOOL, UPON GRADUATION FROM PURDUE UNIVERSITY, WEST LAFAYETTE, INDIANA IN 1966 THROUGH THE NESEP PROGRAM. HIS FIRST SEA TOUR AFTER HIS COMMISSION WAS ON BOARD USS O'HARE (DD-889) AS COMMUNICATIONS OFFICER. IN 1968 HE WAS ASSIGNED TO DESTROYER SCHOOL, NEWPORT, RHODE ISLAND AS A STUDENT IN THE DEPARTMENT HEAD CURRICULUM. HE THEN ASSUMED DUTIES AS ENGINEER OFFICER ABOARD USS DOUGLAS H. FOX (DD-779) IN 1969.

IN 1970, CDR FERDON WAS TRANSFERRED TO USS LAFFEY (DD-724) WHERE HE SERVED AS ENGINEER OFFICER UNTIL 1972. HIS NEXT ASSIGNMENT WAS AT DESTROYER SCHOOL AS AN INSTRUCTOR IN THE ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT UNTIL 1974.

CDR FERDON ASSUMED THE DUTIES AS EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF USS AYLWIN (FF-1081) IN 1975 AND THEN ATTENDED THE ARMED FORCES STAFF COLLEGE IN NORFOLK VA. IN MARCH 1977 HE REPORTED AS EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF NAVY RECRUITING DISTRICT, MEMPHIS.

AFTER COMPLETION OF SENIOR OFFICER SHIPS MATERIAL READINESS COURSE IN IDAHO FALLS IN 1980. HE RETURNED TO SEA DUTY AS ENGINEER OFFICER OF THE USS LEXINGTON (AVT-16).

CDR FERDON IS MARRIED TO THE FORMER DONNA JEANNE HOLLAND OF CORINTH, NEW YORK. THEY HAVE TWO SONS, MICHAEL (AGE 21) AND KENNETH (AGE 19).

HIS DECORATIONS INCLUDE THE NAVY COMMENDATION MEDAL, MERITORIOUS UNIT COMMENDATION WITH 2 BRONZE STARS, GOOD CONDUCT MEDAL WITH ONE BRONZE STAR, VIETNAM SERVICE MEDAL, NATIONAL DEFENSE MEDAL, AND THE SEA SERVICE RIBBON.

CDR FERDON HAS BEEN AWARDED A MASTERS DEGREE (OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT) FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS.

CDR FERDON ASSUMED COMMAND OF USS DAVIDSON (FF-1045) ON 7 OCTOBER 1982.



LCDR T. D. KELLY EXECUTIVE OFFICER


LCDR KELLY RECEIVED HIS COMMISSION THROUGH THE NROTC PROGRAM AT PRAIRIE VIEW ASM UNIVERSITY, PRAIRIE VIEW, TEXAS IN MAY 1971. HE WAS INITIALLY ASSIGNED AS COMBAT INFORMA-TION OFFICER ABOARD USS CLAUD JONES (DE 1033), HOMEPORTED IN PEARL HARBOR, HAWAII. IN APRIL 1973, LCDR KELLY DETACHED FROM THE CLAUD JONES ENROUTE DALLAS, TEXAS.

IN DALLAS, LCDR KELLY JOINED THE NAVY'S RECRUITING FORCE AS A MEMBER OF NAVY RECRUITING AREA SEVEN. HE REMAINED THERE UNTIL JUNE 1974 WHEN HE TRANSFERRED TO THE NAVY RECRUITING DISTRICT, DALLAS, TEXAS. IN DECEMBER 1975, LCDR KELLY DEPARTED DALLAS HEADING FOR THE NAVY'S SURFACE WARFARE SCHOOL COMMAND IN NEWPORT, RHODE ISLAND TO JOIN THE CLASS OF '51 OF THE DEPARTMENT HEAD COURSE.

IN AUGUST 1976, LCDR KELLY COMPLETED THE DEPARTMENT HEAD COURSE AND AFTER A COUPLE OF FOLLOW-ON COURSES, REPORTED TO THE USS RAMSEY (FFG 2) AS THE CHIEF ENGINEER. TWENTY-TWO MONTHS LATER, IN SPETEMBER 1978, HE DETACHED FROM RAMSEY AND REPORTED TO THE USS MONTICELLO (LSD 35) AS FIRST LIEUTENANT. IN APRIL 1980, HE DETACHED FROM USS MONTICELLO AND REPORTED TO THE COMMANDER, NAVAL MILITARY PERSONNEL COMMAND. THERE HE JOINED THE SURFACE JUNIOR OFFICER ASSIGNMENT BRANCH AND REMAINED UNTIL OCTOBER 1981.


IN OCTOBER 1981, LCDR KELLY RETURNED TO THE SURFACE WARFARE OFFICER SCHOOL COMMAND TO ATTEND THE PROSPECTIVE EXECUTIVE OFFICER COURSE. IN DECEMBER 1981, LCDR KELLY ASSUMED THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BILLET IN USS RICHARD S. EDWARDS (DD 950) AND REMAINED THERE UNTIL HER DECOMMISSIONING IN DECEMBER 1982. FOLLOWING A SHORT PERIOD WITH COMDESSON TWENTY-FIVE, HE REPORTED TO USS DAVIDSON TO START HIS SECOND EXECUTIVE OFFICER AFLOAT TOUR. LCDR KELLY COMPLETED HIS TOUR ABOARD DAVIDSON IN AUGUST 1984 AND REPORTED TO HIS PRESENT ASSIGNMENT AS CHIEF STAFF OFFICER FOR COMMANDER, DESTROYER SQUADRON THIRTY-FIVE.



EMFN MICHAEL PAUL SMITH, USN


